Niax silicone L-6869 is a non-hydrolysable silicone copolymer used primarily for resin-side addition in the manufacture of rigid polyurethane foams blown with hydrocarbons and/or HFCs/HFOs to improve foam flow-ability and provide low thermal conductivity.
